Hospital Billing Policies

Thank you for choosing Marion General Hospital for your healthcare needs. The following is a summary of our billing practices.

Costs and Billing

The payment of a deductible and/or co-pays will be requested at time of service. If a patient does not have insurance, a down payment of \$100 for an Emergency Department visit will be requested. Uninsured patients also will be asked to make a down payment of \$500 for all inpatient stays and outpatient procedures.

You will receive a copy of your hospital bill within a few weeks after your hospital stay. You also may receive other bills from your doctor(s), including your family doctor or specialists.

Cost of healthcare services are available from Marion General's Patient Access Department, which was previously known as Patient Registration. This office is located on the hospital's first floor, adjacent to the front lobby Welcome Desk. This information also is available from our Patient Accounts Office, which is located in Marion General's Office & Conference Center, located at 278 Barks Road West, or by calling the Patient Access Department at 740/383-8475.

It is important to us to correctly manage your hospital bill. If you have any questions about charges, please call Patient Accounts at 740/383-8530.

If your insurance plan does not pay your bill(s) within 90 days, or your claim is denied, you will receive a statement from Marion General Hospital indicating the bill is now your responsibility. All bills sent to you are due upon receipt.

Marion General Hospital does not charge interest on any amount not paid in full during the normal course of collection.

Financial Assistance

We are pleased to offer financial assistance to patients with limited resources and inadequate medical insurance coverage. Eligibility is determined by total family income and assets.

Marion General Hospital's Charity Care Policy

Marion General Hospital is part of the OhioHealth family of not-for-profit, faith-based healthcare facilities. Marion General Hospital and OhioHealth tailor policies to address the needs of each community it serves and provide one of the most compassionate charity care policies to individuals and families who cannot pay for healthcare services they receive at our facilities.

Marion General Hospital's charity care policy includes:

- Substantial charity care guidelines that provide free care for individuals and families who earn less than 100 percent of the federal poverty level.
- Sliding scale fees to provide substantially discounted care for individuals and families who are between 100 and 400 percent of the federal poverty level.
- Hardship policy for patients who would not otherwise qualify for charity care, but have unique circumstances.

In many cases, Marion General Hospital offers interest free loans for up to six months to assist patients. Marion General Hospital also has an uninsured discount policy, for individuals without insurance who do not qualify for charity care.
